

RULES FOR OCT. 3-4, 2015 FAMILY OVERNIGHT CAMP

To ensure the enjoyment of all park visitors:

- As with all park functions, alcohol is not permitted in the park.
- The Family Overnight Camp is for tent camping ONLY. Tents must be set up within campsites designated by Hendricks County Parks & Recreation staff. Pop-up campers are not permitted in campsites.
- Tent camping is for immediate family members (parents & children). Accommodations can be made when registering to allow requested families to have adjoining campsites. (Indicate your preference in the "Notes" section of the registration form.)
- You may cook on the grills and campfires provided, but please do not bring in grills or start fires anywhere else in the park.
- Stay on designated trails and campsites to protect plants, to prevent erosion, and to avoid poison ivy and stinging nettles. Bicycles are not allowed on park trails.
- Family Camp-Out check-in will take place at the Nature Center on Saturday, Oct. 3, from 2:00pm to 4:00pm.
- Check-out time (tents and camping gear removed from campsites) is Sunday, Oct. 4, by 11:00am (but families are invited to stay and enjoy the park all day!). If you carry something into the park, please carry it out when you leave.
- Please leave the park as beautiful as you found it; plants, animals, and other property need to remain in the park for all to enjoy.
- Because McCloud Park is a wildlife refuge and is to be used for quiet enjoyment, please keep noise within respectable levels at all times. Amplified music is not permitted within the park.
- "Quiet Hours" will be observed from 10:00pm Saturday until 8:00am Sunday. To help us maintain the security of the park, please refrain from driving vehicles into or out of the park during those times (except in an emergency).
- Fireworks/firearms are not allowed in the park.
- Weather cancellation: Hendricks County Parks will cancel the October 3-4 Family Camp-Out in the event of unseasonably cold temperatures (20 degrees F) or a forecast of steady rain. If campers feel any other weather forecast would compromise the event for their family, they may cancel their registration and request a full refund up to 3 business days prior to Oct. 3rd.
