



W.S. Gibbs Memorial Park Rules

- W.S. Gibbs Memorial Park is open from dawn to dusk daily.
- Leave the park as beautiful as you found it by not removing any plants, animals, rocks, geodes, artifacts, or other property from the park.
- If you carry something into the park, carry it out when you leave.
- All dogs must be on a leash and under the control of their owner. Pick up after your pets.
- To keep W.S. Gibbs Memorial Park safe, clean, peaceful, and enjoyable for everyone (including the wildlife), the following items are prohibited in the park:
 - Alcoholic beverages
 - Amplified music, including loud stereos
 - Outside grills or fires anywhere in the park
 - Fireworks
 - Drones or other motorized aircraft
 - Four-wheelers, ATVs, or other off-road vehicles
 - Mushroom hunting
 - Horses
 - Hunting
- Stay on designated trails. This helps prevent erosion, damage to animal habitat, and possible contact with plants such as poison ivy, poison oak, stinging nettles, etc.
- Vehicles must remain on designated roads and parking areas. This includes, but is not limited to, golf carts of any kind, motorcycles, and e-motos.
- Bicycles, Class 1 e-bikes, Class 2 e-bikes, and e-scooters are allowed on park trails with a speed limit of 15 mph and must yield to foot traffic. Class 3 e-bikes are only allowed on roadways and parking lots.
- No swimming, wading, or boating is permitted in any of the ponds. Stay off the ice in the winter.
- Sledding is at your own risk.
